



Structure of the Organization

Board of Directors - The Directors are elected to lead the organization toward the established vision and values. The Directors set overall policy and direction for the organization.

Officers - The officers form a small group selected from amongst the Directors, known most often as the Executive or Management Group. (Note that the term Executive Officer is sometimes used to describe the senior staff person in some organizations.) Between board of Directors meetings, this group guides the day-to-day implementation of policy and other functions delegated by the Board. The Officers are not normally a policy group.

Committees - Program or service units are appointed to carry out the wide variety of tasks necessary in any organization. In most cases, committee members will be elected from the organization's membership.

Membership - In a membership organization, it is members who provide the authority for the senior leadership to act. The members elect or select the Directors, identify needs and provide broad direction. they are the ultimate stewards of the organization's vision and values.

Volunteers – Barrington Area Soccer Association would not function without the volunteers. Our coaches, parents and many others who help to make every season possible.
